Scope

Focusing on the e-Health domain in general, EHST 2012 aims at bringing together researchers and practitioners whose work has impact on the development of actual healthcare technologies. Such technologies relate to advanced IT solutions and could facilitate activities of great societal relevance. In particular, the symposium considers e-Health services and their related technologies, with a particular stress on the modeling of complex e-Health technology-driven service-provisioning systems. Some fundamental modeling challenges related to e-Health services are to be addressed. In approaching such services though, we are mainly concerned with Tele-Monitoring and Tele-Treatment, as two essential directions of supporting healthcare through advanced technology. Further, in order for e-Health services to be successfully deployed in routine care, the services need to fit the needs of the users and clinical effectiveness should be proven. Research dedicated toward user-driven design approaches and validation trials are very welcome to the EHST 2012.
